Social Dis-Dance-Sing is the right thing! For Parents...

~Plan to drop your student (ages 12 and over) off in the parking lot in back for access to the elevator or at the east side of the building (People's United Bank) where students can enter the building via stairwell

~Please wear your mask and follow safe distancing rules as you come into the building with younger students - one parent only

~Pick your student up at the stairwell exit on the west side of the building as they are escorted from the studio by a staff member, following the traffic flow around the parking lot.

Social Dis-Dance-Sing is the right thing! For Students...

~ A staff member will meet you at the door for touch-less temperature check and a stop at the hand-sanitizing station

~ GDPAA students (only) will enter through the main double doors and follow staff instructions for storing dance bags and coats and entering into classrooms

~Please remember-no extra backpacks, street or school attire will be allowed

~Always wear your mask and follow safe distancing rules while in the hallways, lobby, restroom and classrooms

~Come to class with your mask, in full dance attire with appropriate dance shoes and hair up. Changing and lingering in the dancers' area, hallways or restrooms is not permitted

~Exit through the assigned studio door and leave the building by the stairwell at the end of the hallway by Studio B escorted by a staff member

Sanitizing & Cleaning

~Instructors have time built in between classes to disinfect bathrooms, door handles, barres and other 'touchable' surfaces

~Studio floors, lobby and instructors' areas and offices will be sanitized daily

Please Stay Home if...

~ your student is not feeling well for any reason, is unusually tired, has a fever, persistent cough or takes any medications that cause them to be immunocompromised

~Follow the CDC guidelines to decide what is the safest for you, your student and the GD&PAA family and staff
